You are invited to join the Piquette T's Chapter, MTFCI in celebrating the Centennial of the Model T Ford. Our tour is centered in Ypsilanti, Michigan. Ypsilanti is conveniently situated just west of Detroit, very near rural country driving and a short drive away from The Henry Ford, where our festivities will begin. Ypsilanti is also the home of a fine **Fire Museum**, the **Miller Hudson Dealership** and museum, (the oldest continually operating Hudson dealership in the world!) and the very pleasant and historic shopping district known as **Depot Town**, all of which are included in our plans!

Tuesday will be another day of rural touring along Michigan's back roads. This tour will be shorter to accommodate the evening's **vintage fashion show event** and **dinner banquet** at the Marriott. Lunch will also be included on this day.
