Note, however, that when inside the clubhouse, the dress codes, while relaxed during the boating season, remain in effect. Slacks, shorts, shirts and shoes are acceptable on the first floor in all areas except the front entrance and lobby. A coat and slacks for men and a dress or slacks and blouse for women is required in the front entry area and on the second or third floors which include points of interest such as the Main Dining Room, Ballroon, Trophy Room, indoor pool, etc.

In appreciation of your participation you will receive a commemorative dash plaque and one complimentary ticket to the brunch. Additional brunch tickets may be purchased using credit cards only. See the registration form for information on how to establish your dining time and/or make additional reservations. Reservations for both are essential.
